Currently, we have an opening for a Saturday and Sunday shift from 9:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. with a 30-minute lunch break every 6 hours. Part-time employees work a maximum of 24 hours per week, if scheduling allows. Workdays include weekends and special event days (possibly weekdays).

## DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide interpretive presentations & tours of the Watershed Exhibit for museum guests
  - Conduct formal water science lessons for school groups & adult tours
  - Assist with our on-site restaurant composting operations
  - Assist with special event day activities (i.e. culture days, summer camp, Earth Day, etc.)
  - Orient, equip paddlers for canoe/kayak rentals & lead guided paddles on Bayou Vermilion
  - Routine maintenance of Watershed Exhibit equipment & exhibit area then document
  - Become knowledgeable about pertinent topics in the exhibit so you can offer intelligent answer
  - Report maintenance issues and other related problems to director
